Ludington Area Senior Center	\$1,300	The Ludington Senior Center would like to provide a free Christmas Dinner to area seniors. 100 meals would be served.
Mason County Eastern Schools	\$1,500	Food, clothing and supplies for our school pantry to help Mason County Eastern Students and Families.
Mason County Historical Society	\$1,300	To make new vegetable garden boxes in the Burn's Family Farmhouse vegetable garden at Historic White Pine Village. Food grown in the garden is donated to people in need.

Ludington Youth Sailing School	\$850	We received a grant last year for floating docks, we got three floating docks from the city marina, these docks need some additional hardware to convert them for sailing school use.
PoWeR! Book Bags	\$1,500	500 books for children at the Salvation Army, COVE, and Lakeshore Food Club for the Christmas Give-Aways
Sandcastles Children's Museum	\$1,500	New tables for our party/program room. Our current tables are very old, and they are not level and most wobble. Very hard when you are building or painting a project on them during a workshop.
Shoreline FORCE	\$1,500	Hire a landscape architect to design a preliminary plan for a park garden which is used to educate children on how to safely ride on the areas mountain bike trails
Staircase Youth Services	\$1,000	Driver's training for 2 youth and household items for youth going into transitional living and our rapid re-housing program such as pots/pans, laundry basket, bedding, and beds.
